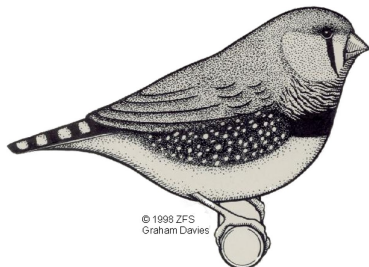

SELLING CLASSES

Entry fee £1-00 per cage. A fixed price to be set by the seller, 10% of which will go to the Z.F.S., when the birds are sold. Birds can be purchased by anyone, who has paid the admission to the show. They can only be viewed and purchased when the show hall is open. Under 16's must be accompanied by an adult.

- S1 Any Pair of Zebra Finches (cock and hen of same colour or mutation)
- S2 Any Two Zebra Finches (any sex any colour or mutation)
- S3 Any Single Zebra Finch
- S4 Any Other Variety Bird

SHOW RULES

1. Zebra Finches entered in pair classes must be shown in true pairs of the same colour and only exhibits benched in Z.F.S. standard show cages are eligible for specials.
2. Care must be taken to enter birds in the correct classes; no reclassification will be made once birds have been entered.
3. Only Officials will be allowed in the Show Hall while judging is in progress.
4. Only birds entered in show classes may be brought into the Show Hall.
5. The purchase of sales birds must be made through the Sales Steward.
6. Every care will be taken of exhibits and equipment, but no responsibility for loss or damage will be undertaken by the Show Committee or the Z.F.S.
7. Birds will not be accepted if they are in poor physical condition or in dirty cages.
8. All Exhibits are subject to the Show Rules of the Z.F.S.
9. Lifting time will commence at 4-00 p.m. No exhibition birds may be removed from the show hall before this time.

10. Any exhibitor wishing to make a protest must do so in writing to the show secretary before the close of the show; together with a £10 deposit which will be forfeited should the protest be deemed frivolous.
11. Any matters arising not covered by these rules will be dealt with by the show committee and their decision will be final and binding.
12. No sales allowed in car parks, deliveries only will be allowed, if ordered prior to the show. (An area inside will be available, please see the Show Manager.)
